Cookie Policy

This Cookie Policy explains how AnchorStone Investments ("AnchorStone," "we," "us," or "our") uses cookies and similar tracking technologies on our website, investor portal, and online services (collectively, the "Site").

By using the Site, you can choose whether to allow certain cookies. Where required by law, we will only set non-essential cookies after you provide consent through our cookie banner or preference tool. You can change or withdraw your choices at any time.

This Cookie Policy should be read together with our Privacy Policy, which explains how we collect, use, and share personal information. Use of the Site is also governed by our Terms of Use, which may contain additional provisions relevant to cookies and tracking technologies

1. What Are Cookies?

Cookies are small text files placed on your device (computer, tablet, or smartphone) when you visit a website. Cookies help websites recognize your device, remember preferences, and support certain functions.

We may also use similar technologies such as pixels, tags, SDKs, and local storage. In this Policy, we refer to these technologies collectively as "cookies" unless stated otherwise.

2. Types of Cookies We Use

Cookies fall into the following categories. The specific cookies used on the Site may change over time; we keep our cookie banner and preference tool updated to reflect current use.

Category	Purpose	Examples
Strictly Necessary Cookies	Required for the Site to function properly and securely. They enable core features such as page navigation, form submissions, fraud prevention, and session management.	Session cookies, security cookies, authentication cookies
Performance and Analytics Cookies	Help us understand how visitors use the Site (for example, which pages are visited most and how users navigate) so we can improve performance and	Analytics tools, aggregated usage statistics

Functionality Cookies	Remember your settings and preferences (such as language, region, or form inputs) to personalize your experience.	Preference cookies, saved settings
Marketing and Advertising Cookies	Used to measure campaign performance and, where enabled, deliver relevant marketing across platforms. These cookies are used only where permitted and, where required, only after you consent.	Advertising pixels, conversion tags
Third-Party Cookies	Set by external services integrated into the Site (for example, embedded video, analytics providers, scheduling tools, or payment processors). These third parties may collect information under their own policies.	Video embeds, payment session cookies, social media widgets

3. How We Use Cookies

We use cookies to:

- Enable core website functionality and security features.
- Remember user preferences and improve your experience.
- Measure Site traffic and understand performance trends.
- Improve our content, design, and features.
- Support marketing and communications (only where enabled and permitted).

4. Third-Party Services

Some cookies may be placed by third parties that provide services we use on the Site (for example, analytics, embedded video, scheduling, or payment processing). These third parties may process data under their own privacy policies.

Examples of third-party categories (which may be used depending on the Site features you access) include:

- Analytics providers (for example, site usage measurement).
- Marketing and advertising platforms (for example, conversion measurement, where enabled).
- Embedded media providers (for example, video playback).
- Scheduling or meeting tools (for example, booking a call).
- Payment processors (if payment features are offered).

If third-party cookies are used, we will describe them in our cookie banner or preference tool when required.

5. Managing Cookies and Your Choices

You can manage cookies in several ways:

- Cookie banner or preference tool: If available on the Site, you can adjust cookie settings by category and withdraw consent at any time.
- Browser settings: Most browsers allow you to block or delete cookies. You can also set your browser to notify you when cookies are being used.

Please note: blocking some cookies (especially strictly necessary cookies) may cause parts of the Site to function improperly or reduce personalization.

Global Privacy Controls

Some jurisdictions recognize browser-based signals such as the Global Privacy Control (GPC). Where required by applicable law, we will treat such signals as a request to opt out of certain data processing (for example, sale or sharing of personal information) for the browser or device that sends the signal.

Do Not Track

Some browsers offer a "Do Not Track" feature. Because there is no consistent industry standard for responding to Do Not Track signals, we do not respond to them in a uniform way. If this changes, we will update this Policy.

6. Data Retention

Cookies have varying lifespans:

- Session cookies expire when you close your browser.
- Persistent cookies remain on your device for a defined period (often between 6 and 24 months) or until you delete them.

We periodically review cookies to ensure retention is limited to what is necessary for their purpose.

7. Regional Disclosures

EU/UK/EEA Visitors

If you access the Site from the European Union, United Kingdom, or other jurisdictions that require consent for non-essential cookies, we will only place non-essential cookies (such as analytics and

marketing cookies) after you provide explicit consent through our cookie banner. You may withdraw consent at any time using the same tool.

We rely on consent for non-essential cookies and our legitimate interests (such as ensuring site security and basic functionality) for strictly necessary cookies.

United States (including California)

Depending on the services used on the Site, certain cookies and tracking technologies may be considered "sharing" of personal information for cross-context behavioral advertising under some U.S. state privacy laws (including California). Where applicable, we will provide an option to opt out through our cookie banner or a "Do Not Sell or Share My Personal Information" mechanism.

AnchorStone does not knowingly collect personal information from children under 13, and the Site is not directed to children.

Where applicable, we will provide an option to opt out through our cookie banner or a 'Do Not Sell or Share My Personal Information' link or similar control available on the Site.
